## **SOCCER PROGRAM:**

**Girls and Boys divisions for U8, U10 and U12

This is a **recreational NO CUT** program. Grade 10/11/12 teams play an interlocking schedule with the West Zone teams, and depending on the number of participants, Grade 7/8/9 teams may also play an interlocking schedule with the West Zone. Everyone else, with the exception of Lakeview U4 and U6, will be placed on teams that play all games within the areas of Lakeview, Whitmore, Hillsdale and Albert Park. ## Soccer Program Volunteer Information

**Equipment Coordinators (4)** – Gather “on hand” equipment and make up team packages (bag, game ball, & extra practice balls, cones, flags, nets and label for each team). Needs to be completed before ball inflation day, April 17th.

**Equipment Team:** *Ball inflation* - Gather for 1.5 to 2 hours **April 17** to inflate 1200 or so balls.

*Jerseys* - sort and package team jerseys - 2 to 3 hours. There are about 96 teams. More volunteers = more fun! Contact the coordinator in your area to offer your assistance. Thank you!

**Team Building:** A Coordinator and 9 others to build teams in each age group. Time requirement depends on the number of registrations. Will need to be completed in the last two weeks of March

**Game Schedulers** – A Coordinator and 2 or 3 other people. A scheduling program was located on the net, which can be used. Schedule games and field usage. Will need to be completed in the first two weeks of April.

**Windup organizers:** Book a company to flip burgers, order enough burgers/dogs, chips and water to supply the tournament. Organize volunteers to serve as required. Contact the coordinator in your area to offer your assistance. Thank you!

**Coaches:** Attend coaches’ clinic **April 17**, and pick up equipment. Notify players/parents of schedule for the season. Hand out a jersey and a soccer ball to each player. Coach in a positive and fun manner while teaching soccer skills when possible.

**Parents:** Cheer in a positive and fun way, providing good sportsmanship examples to all players.

**Website:** Develop a website for South Regina Community Soccer. Could include online registration, posting of game schedules, windup information, and weather cancellation(s), etc. Have ready for 2011 season.

Shoe Swap coordinator – Plan for 2011 season or indoor.
