SOCCKER PROGRAM

Girls and Boys divisions: U8, U10 and U12

Co-ed divisions: U4, U5, U6, U15 and U19

This is a **recreational NO CUT** program.

Season runs May 2 to June 18, 2011.

Monday through Thursday, 2 games per week.

Each player will receive their own soccer jersey and U4 to U12 will receive a ball each to bring to games.

Grade 10/11/12 (U19) teams play an interlocking schedule with the West Zone teams, and depending on the number of participants, Grade 7/8/9 (U15) teams may also play an interlocking schedule with the West Zone. Everyone else will be placed on teams that play all games within the areas of Lakeview, Whitmore, Hillsdale and Albert Park.

Duties: Attend coaches' clinic **April 16** and pick up equipment. Notify players/parents of schedule for the season. Coach teams in a positive manner. Sign-up as a coach and help your child and children in your area learn and enjoy a wonderful sport! Indicate your interest at registration.

EQUIPMENT COORDINATORS (4)

Duties: Gather "on hand" equipment and organize into team packages (bag, game ball, & extra practice balls, cones, flags, nets and label for each team). This needs to be completed before ball inflation day, April 16th.

Soccer Volunteer Requirements & Information

Equipment Team:

Ball inflation - Gather for 1.5 to 2 hours **April 16** to inflate 1000 or so balls and to batch in team kits.

Jerseys - Gather for 2 -3 hours to sort and package team jerseys. There are approximately 96 teams. More volunteers = more fun! Contact the Soccer Coordinator in your area to offer your assistance. Thank you!

Team Building: A Coordinator and nine others to organize players into teams in each age group. Time requirement depends on the number of registrations. Will need to be completed in the last two weeks of March

Game Schedulers: A Coordinator and two to three other people. Schedule games and field usage. Will need to be completed in the first two weeks of April.

Windup organizers: Book a company to flip burgers, order enough burgers/dogs, chips and water to supply the tournament. Organize volunteers to serve as required. Contact the Coordinator in your area to offer your assistance. Thank you!

Parents: Cheer in a positive and fun way, providing good sportsmanship examples to all players.
